# Volunteer Rewards Program

For volunteers with Payne County Youth Services!

Beginning October 1, 2011

A **Volunteer** means a person who has met with the PCYS Personnel Assistant, has completed required paperwork, has authorized PCYS to complete an OSBI background check\* and has been found to have a clean record, has had their picture taken and received an official PCYS name tag. A Volunteer Intern is not eligible during the course of internship.

\*A fee of \$20 is requested from the applying **Volunteer** to offset the cost of the OSBI background check.

\*\* Gold Star = 1 point; Red Star = 2 points; Green Star = 3 points

**NOTE: All Volunteers MUST log in and out on the Volunteer Log Sheet, at the front desk of both Shelter and Administrative offices. If the volunteering is performed at an off-site event, a volunteer sign-in log will be present.**

**Volunteer's** picture will be taken and displayed in the PCYS Shelter Office and Administrative/Outpatient Office (with consent)

**Volunteer** will receive 1 gold star\*\* for each hour of volunteering with PCYS.

Should **Volunteer** bring others with him to assist with a task, the **Volunteer** will receive a Red Star\*\*.

If **Volunteer** recruits a new **Volunteer**, the recruiting **Volunteer** will receive a Green Star\*\* after the new **Volunteer** completes paperwork and upon the first hour volunteered by the new **Volunteer**.

At the beginning of the month following the end of each quarter, the **Volunteer** with the most points will be named as
